Connect Parent/Carer Survey Report: Prescribing the Minimum Number of Learning Hours

Many thanks to the 243 parents and carers from 31 local authorities who responded to our survey for the Scottish Government's consultation on *Prescribing the Minimum Number of Learning Hours in Schools*. You can read our submission to the consultation and the background documents <u>here</u>.

The majority of respondents agreed with the proposals to prescribe learning hours, but there was much less confidence in the proposals to make exceptions to the prescribed hours for local authorities to use. Here, a lack of clarity, fears that children and young people could be negatively impacted by reduced learning hours and the potential for local authorities to use 'loopholes' to save money were concerns.
