2. School updates

<u>COVID</u>

- Pupil bubbles are gone, so better support for pupils is possible
- Guidance still states that doors and windows are to be kept open
- There are still positive COVID cases in the school class specific school app channels keep parents up-to-date
- School hopes to be able to meet parents face-to-face before the summer break
- Mask wearing for teachers is now a choice, once they are in the classrooms

- School is looking forward to open up more but subject to guidance
- Full assemblies and trips will be taken up again, once guidance allows

<u>What's going on in school</u>

- Kate E Deeming funding was used to offer pupils participation in Circus skill workshops
- Scottish Culture Days and Financial Week
- Some class groups were able to do Museum visits to Edinburgh
- New game resources to be bought in in March
- SHRE programme to start end of February
- Seasons for Change, 3rd season to start
- A Celtic Connection workshop was held in school, but traffic noise prevented a Ceilidh outside
- Chinese New year celebrations
- Internet Safety talks

3. Residential for P7s this year

- It is not likely that this can go ahead, due to limited choices for booking remaining
- PC enquired on what can be done to still make it happen capacity of suitable accommodation and cost of remaining options are the hurdles.
- In the past, the cost for the residential week for families was about £150
- Another issue is staff cover for those who would travel, and cover in the school during that time

4. Use of school facilites (Pitch)

- School advised that use till 4pm is without cost (Pollokshields Primary uses this for their Monday Football Club)
- Outwith these times, Glasgow Letting would be contact for use of facilities
- There are different bands of cost depending on who wants to use the facilities.
- To hire the hall for 3 hours costs the school for the Winter Fayre £170 !

5. Transitions

- P7 to go to Secondary receive support for transitions by Quarriers
- P1 transitions planned in person on Tuesday, the 31st May and Wednesday the 1st of June (mornings)
- PC may want to be present to meet new parents

Action -PC to consider to organise a stall for second hand uniforms (ask Parent Forum for donations)

6. Co-operation with Glendale Gaelic School

- PC enquired about the potential to work together with the Gaelic School for events and input on facilities to benefit all children on the campus
- We want to consider how to get involved into the Eco Parents Group Gaelic used to run. One area of working together would be more planting on the fence to St Andrew's Drive
